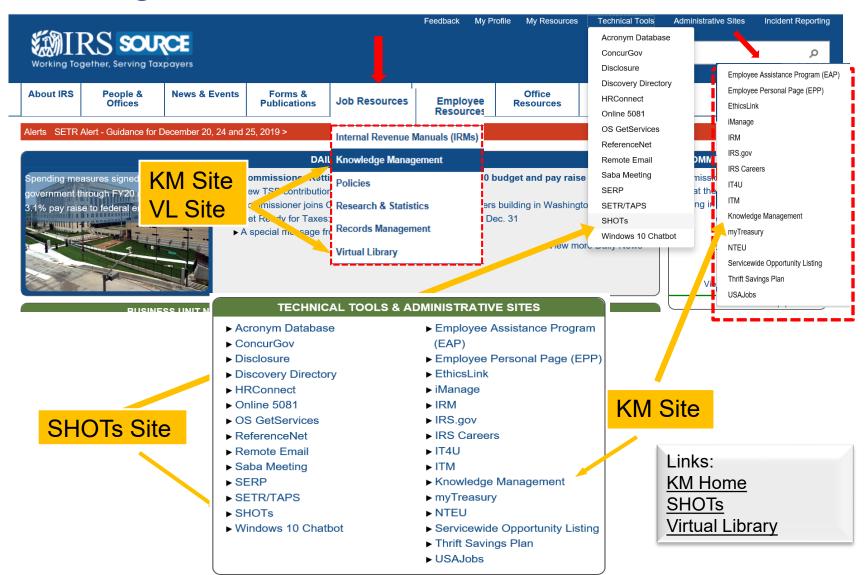

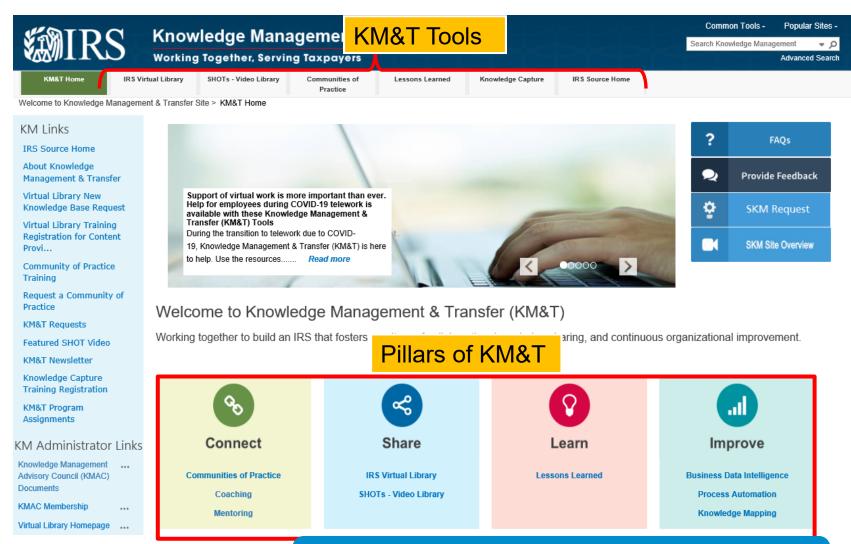


IRS Locating the KM Site





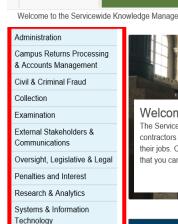

- · Create and share ideas

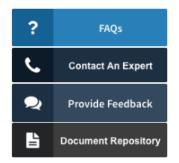
This knowledge base is the home for all things related to Communities of Practice at the IRS. The books contain tools and resources for those who want to join, create and lead communities.

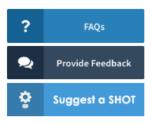
Welcome to SHOTs

Welcome to the Knowledge Capture Site

Knowledge Capture provides a comprehensive, priority-driven approach to capturing subject matters or processes that align to an identified need of an organization. It should be centered on a topic-based approach that drives the retention of knowledge throughout an employee's career and aligns with workforce priorities. The process is flexible and the various activities and tools shown in the books below should be tailored to meet your organization's needs. One or more of the activities described for each step of the framework can be leveraged.

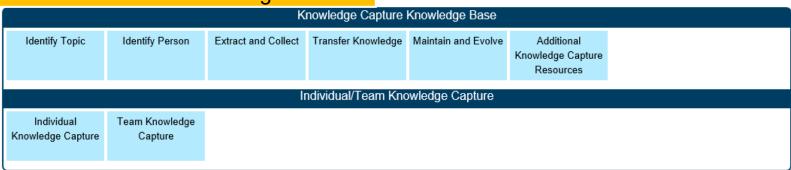
Types of Knowledge Capture

- Knowledge Bases Process for addressing topics that pertain to a Servicewide audience. Content should ultimately be incorporated into the Virtual Library
- 2. Teams Covers information for a specific project that is gathered retrospectively. Should be housed on a local team Sharepoint site
- Individual Information often captured during exit interviews due to retirement or job changes to help ensure business continuity and should be passed on to the employee's direct replacement or housed on a local site
